

We send you greetings in the Lord, who continually keeps us all in His love and grace. Under His care and provision, the work goes on well. Glory be to His name!

Here, we are all doing by God's grace. The school holidays are almost over. School is set to resume on September 15. As a result, both parents and children are preparing for it. For the former, it can be a stressful time because school fees must be paid, school supplies purchased, and new school uniforms sewn. Our son, Matt, is also preparing for it. We are happy that he was able to spend part of his vacation in Ghana with some of his cousins. Stella did a good job arranging everything about his trip for him. Now, the Bible and Sporting Games Day, planned for the youth this first part of September, is going to be their last vacation activity.

The youth ministry in Sanguera has been fully launched. We currently have 17 young people being helped through this ministry. They had a special program in July which helped them to be better-grounded in the knowledge of the fundamentals of our Christian faith. It went very well. One of the things emphasized during their program, of which I was very pleased, was the need for a greater understanding of the necessity to get involved in the Christian work at an early age. With all this and the program in place to have them get together with the youth from other partner Baptist churches at least once yearly, we believe that the Lord is really going to help and use them.

Evangelism continues as usual almost every Saturday morning. Three souls have been saved this past month and two added to the church. By the grace of God, seven people were baptized.

We thank the Lord for your giving toward the church construction need in Sanguera. Construction works are due to commence after Easter next year because Sanguera is hosting our next Annual Easter Convention; the empty plot of land where the new church building is to stand will need to be used for the Convention tent as well as other things. This arrangement also allows us sufficient time to fully prepare and get the church people ready for it.
